Introduction

Tanzania faces significant challenges in achieving economic self-reliance, particularly among low-income households and vulnerable groups. These include orphans, persons with disabilities, disadvantaged students, widows, the elderly, single mothers, and children who are unaware of their rights and responsibilities. Even when resources are available, many communities lack awareness of economic opportunities, essential personal and entrepreneurial skills, and knowledge to start and manage development projects. Limited stakeholder engagement, poor savings practices, inadequate health education, gender-based violence, and insufficient infrastructure further hinder economic growth, with the erosion of moral and cultural values, and the limited understanding of national heritage among younger generations, Gen Z, weakening social cohesion, and patriotism. By collaborating with the government and other stakeholders, we aim to provide immediate support and long-term solutions through economic empowerment, education, skills training, sustainable projects, and the strengthening of moral values to build a strong, confident society with equal opportunities for all.
